

Department of Crime Victim Compensation (DCVC) VICTIM ASSISTANCE FINES, FEES AND ASSESSMENT FUND TIPS

All Victim Assistance Programs should have the following information on file and or distributed to all relevant personnel:

- ➤ Victim Service Provider (VSP) Certification Number from the Office of Victim Services Education and Certification (OVSEC)
- ➤ VSP Certification (Basic Core 15hrs within 1 year after hire date; afterwards, 12hrs annually as legislatively mandated)
- Current Job Descriptions on file with the County or Municipal HR Office for all victim advocates and update as warranted
- Written Comprehensive Victim Assistance Program Policies and Procedures
- Current Comprehensive Victim Assistance Procedural Manual (Sample located on DCVC website below under the advocate tab)
- Victim Assistance Statistical Tracking and Reporting System
- Victim Assistance Publication Items such as programs, brochures and flyers. (Prevention activities are not allowable)
