Have You Heard About SOVA?

The South Carolina Crime Victims' Compensation Fund is a financial assistance program designed to help victims with expenses directly resulting from a crime that are not covered by other payment sources. It is administered by the State Office of Victim Assistance (SOVA), and is governed by state and federal laws. If victims qualify and meet the eligibility requirements for the program, certain costs for recovery treatment or burial arrangements up to the maximum allowed by law; which is \$15,000, may be considered with proper documents.
